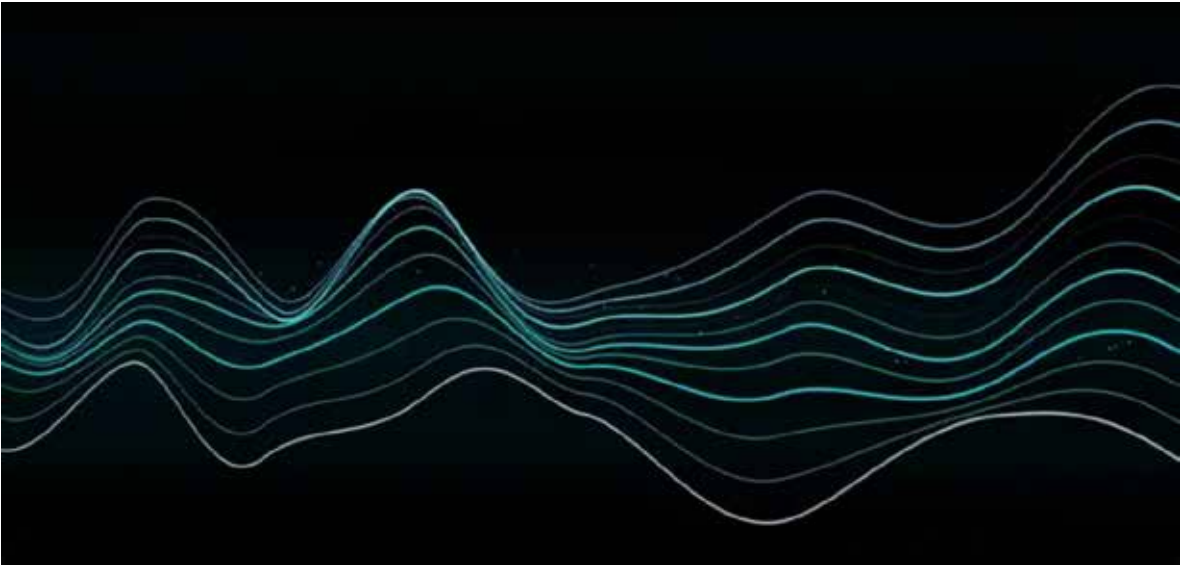




: any of the very small increments or parcels into which many forms of energy are subdivided

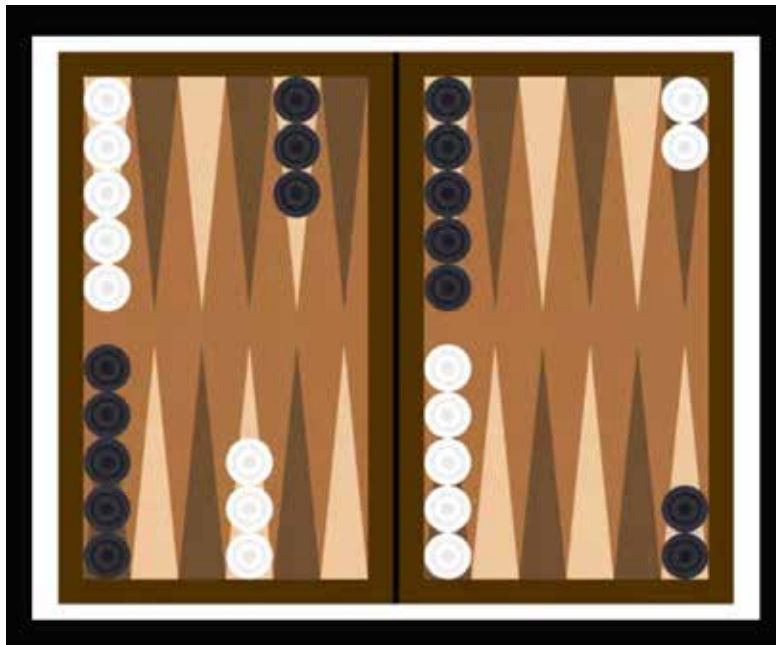

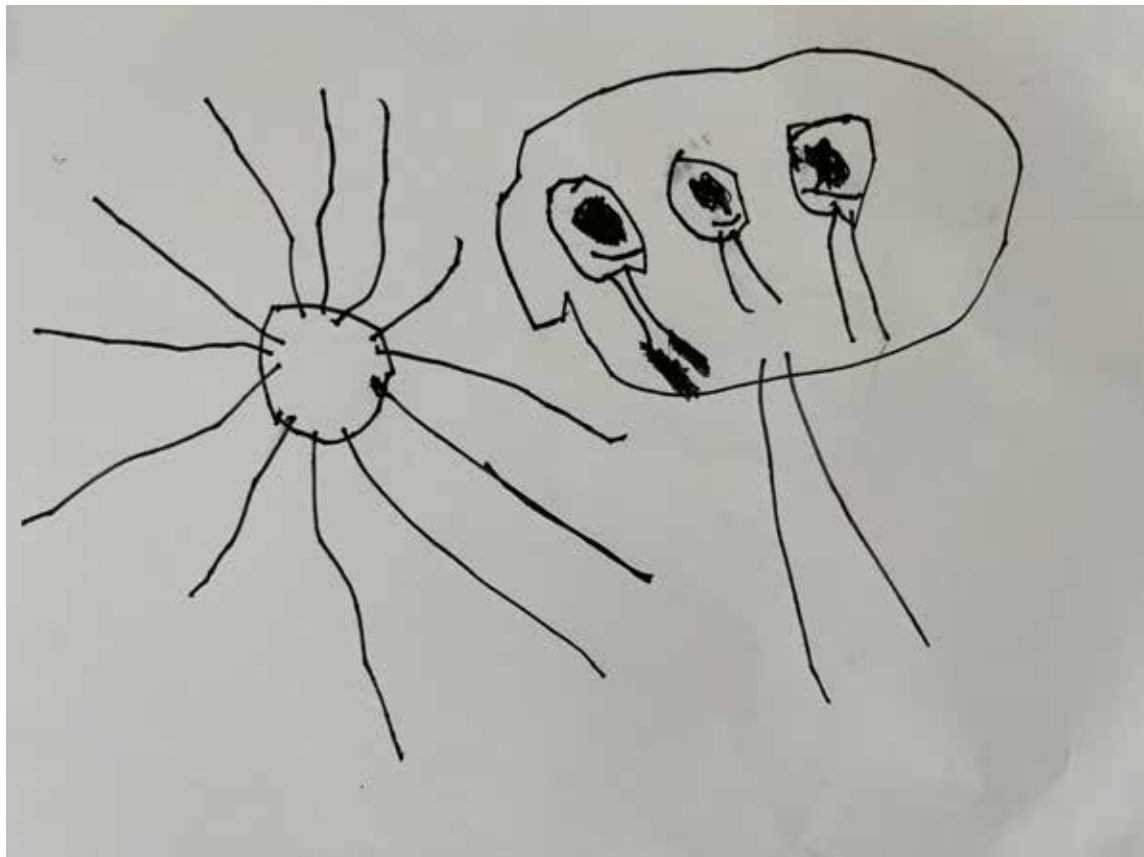
